We hold 4 3-d shoots at the Warren Co Ikes, across the street from Lake Ahquabi State Park. We have a 40-target course in the surrounding woods around the lodge. The course includes both flat and hilly shooting. There is also a tower shot at the halfway point. The course consists of two different loops so archers may start at two different places. There is also a practice range with targets from 10 yards out to 50 yards.

Another plus, archers enjoy is the air-conditioned lodge with modern plumbing facilities for registration and lunch. Check our shoot calendar for shoot dates.
